ABOUT OUR DIRECTOR

Our Director - Mark R. Brosseau

Mark began his performing career when he played the master of ceremonies for a three-ring circus in first grade. He comes from a musically-inclined family and at first self-taught, learned to play a number of instruments early on, finally settling on the saxophone in fourth grade. Mark played in the Monadnock Regional High School Marching Band and Jazz Band and sang in the school chorus and Polyphonic Choir, making All-State chorus for three years. He sang and danced, acted, and played his way through many concerts and shows and was perpetually in front of the curtain as MC for many variety shows and local productions in and out of school.

Mark was class president grade 7-12 and he achieved the rank of Eagle Scout in his senior year by hosting a variety show to benefit the Cedarcrest Center for Children with Disabilities which was in Westmoreland NH at that time. He was featured in the Keene Sentinel's Monadnock Profile in 1980 highlighting his show, music, and a very busy year. Mark began singing barbershop in a quartet in high school after discovering some old music lining the bottom of a band cabinet and gave it a try. He walked a few miles from home to play in the community band at the annual Swanzey Old Homestead production and most recently for over 25 years annually sang barbershop with the farmer's group in the show. He studied Music Education at Keene State College where he played baritone sax in a saxophone quartet and the college Jazz Ensemble.

Mark finally joined the Cheshiremen in 2000 after being an audience member at the chapter annual shows with his family since the age of six. He had the priv-

ilege to sing as a guest under the direction of Dino Houpis, sang and conducted as the Assistant Director under Jim Flanders and as of December 2017, Mark R. Brosseau assumed the honorable position of the sole, front-line director of the Cheshiremen. After nearly 9 years of co-directorship with Jim Kirschner, "The Dynamic Harmonic Duo" has officially retired.

Mark has been singing baritone in the chapter quartet "Heart's Accord" for over 13 years, has quartetted for over 40 years, and was named chapter Barbershopper of the Year in both 2004 and 2015.

Mark lives in Sullivan, NH and works as a designer in the Kitchen, Bath, and Flooring department at Hamshaw Lumber in Keene.





John Devlin was chosen as Cheshiremen of the year as a result of his contribution to the group throughout the year.

John has the experience of teaching music and shares that with the Cheshiremen. He has provided timely tips on how to improve our rehearsal performance, and has re-introduced singing of TAGS.

He is able to help "warm up" the members voices at the beginning of rehearsals, and volunteers without asking. John joined the music committee and played a pivotal part in the selection of music. He was shortly thereafter suggested by several members to be considered for a Board position of "VP of Music and Performance" – Which he graciously accepted.



John began his musical career in school by playing tenor sax. He sang in the chorus and performed in the All State Chorus. 

How & Why **The Con Men?** (it's about barbershop harmony community!)

In 2014, while attending the Society's Harmony University (HU) at Belmont *University* in Nashville, Tennessee, current Cheshiremen member *John Devlin* met and heard *The Con Men* for the first time. They very quickly stood out as one of the premier quartets. John learned that these four college "kids" were medalists on the International stage. John (living in Beaufort, SC at that time)

and his quartet, Eu-4-ia, received coaching from The Con Men at HU. It was clear their enthusiasm for singing, coupled with their vibrant personalities and willingness to share their knowledge - made for an impressive and memorable experience. Upon returning



Beaufort, John recommended that his local chapter chorus, *The Harbormasters*, bring *The ConMen* in for their spring show as the guest quartet. (Now, twice!) John moved back to New Hampshire recently, made the same high recommendation to us and was excited to have *The Con Men* accept our invitation to entertain you today. Enjoy!





About... The Con Men (those early days)


The Con Men have been stealing the show ever since they started singing together back in 2008. All four of them enrolled at *Capital University* the same semester, lived on the same floor of their freshmen dormitory, and studied music together at the *Conservatory of Music*. During college these four young men were all members of the *Capital University* Chapel Choir, the Capital Chordsmen, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Outside of work and school they also found time to be leading members of The Alliance Chorus of Greater Central Ohio, a championship barbershop chorus.

In the spring of 2010, this foursome competed in their first district competition. While not quite able to make the cut, they came back in the fall to win a fifth place bronze medal in the 2010 Johnny Appleseed District (JAD) Quartet Competition. From there



the quartet went on to qualify for the 2011 BHS International Collegiate Quartet Competition. In the fall of 2012 The Con Men had the honor of being named JAD Quartet Champions. For each of the next three years, 2012, 2013, and 2014 they took home third place bronze medals at the BHS International Collegiate Quartet Competitions and a spot among the greatest college quartets in the world.

The quartet is a huge supporter of Society and District Youth In Harmony



programs, and they volunteer their time for many youth choruses and music camps. The Con Men love to share their passion for singing, performing, and the barbershop style more than anything in the world. They look forward to entertaining audiences with their humor and harmony for many more years to come.

The Con Men quartet is:

David Strasser, the tenor, hails from Pickerington, Ohio, a suburb of Columbus. Over the course of his life he has had the opportunity to live in seven different states, and spent 4th and 5th grade living in Mannheim, Germany. David majored in Music Education at *Capital University*, studying voice. Although he sings the tenor part in barbershop, David was actually a member of the bass section in *The Chordsmen* and *Chapel Choir*. He currently lives in German Village, OH and works in fine dining as a bartender.



Matthew Hopper, the lead, was born and raised in Newark, Ohio. In May 2011 he



received a Bachelor of Arts in Music with a minor in History from *Capital University*, studying voice. From July of 2015 to November of 2018, Matthew also directed the *Land of Legend Barbershop Chorus* (Newark, OH chapter). Matthew made the move from Columbus, OH to Nashville, TN in the Fall of 2018 to work as a fundraiser in the Donor Care Center at *Harmony Foundation International*. He loves barbershop harmony, shooting pool, and spending time with friends.

Russell Watterson, the baritone, got hooked on barbershop in high school and has been singing ever since. He graduated with a degree in Computer Science from *Capital University* in 2011. While at Capital, Russell studied voice and was a leading member of many vocal ensembles. He now works in the I.T. department at State Auto Insurance as a Systems Administrator.




